ADDITION TO RESERVATION FORM & CONTRACT

With the changing migration of the Q.L. Caribou it is becoming increasingly necessary for an Outfitter to relocate hunters. In order for us to provide all our clients equal opportunity, we find it necessary to have the following “Moving Policy” accepted by all our hunters.

First one must understand that an Outfitter can only relocate clients where he has an existing camp that has been properly licensed by the Quebec Ministry of Fish & Game. In other words you can not simply fly to the herd, land and shoot a Caribou. Besides being highly unethical it is illegal and any Caribou shot under such circumstances would not be eligible for the record book.

In the past this kind of activity was a common place with a few Quebec Outfitters, as a result Boone & Crockett and Pope & Young threatened to remove Q.L. Caribou from their record books. Something had to be done so J.H.A. led a campaign to have a New Code of Ethics installed in Quebec. We and the other Outfitters must respect this Code of Ethics or there is a great danger of loosing our Q.L. Caribou hunts. We only sell “Fair Chase Hunts”.

Over the years J.H.A. has been able to build up a high ratio of spare camps over a vast area. We have approximately three camps for every camp we book. No other Outfitter has a higher ratio.

However, even than we are not always able to put our hunters in a camp with lots of Caribou. Nor can any other Outfitter. In the past we did all that was possible for our clients success and you can be assured we will continue to do so.

Should we have available a camp that will offer you and your group a better chance of success we will move you “Free of Charge”. However the following conditions will apply:

MOVING POLICY

1. Aircraft and flight conditions permitting.
2. Could be limited to one Caribou each.
3. Could have less services than was originally contracted.
4. Could be limited to one or two days at new camp depending on amount of animals seen.
5. Could have different guides or cooks than originally assigned.
6. Could be brought back to base at Schefferville earlier and in this case the accommodation and meals will be provided for by J.H.A. or if preferred will try to reschedule an earlier flight to Montreal.
7. J.H.A. will make every effort to ship meat and trophies with hunters to Montreal. After arriving in Montreal this becomes the clients responsibility.

Priority will begin with antlers and capes. If for any reason J.H.A. cannot deliver the meat to Montreal on schedule they will reimburse the client a maximum of \$250.00 per animal. Antlers and capes will be shipped at no charge to your home or taxidermist by J.H.A.

I have carefully read this moving policy and do agree to accept this policy on behalf of myself and the other members of my party, and agree to have this policy considered as an addition to the original contract.

It is agreed that this addition to contract is recognized as being signed in Lachute, Quebec, Canada
